

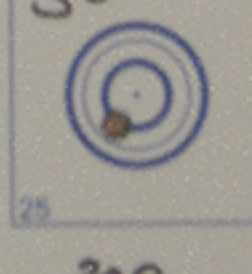
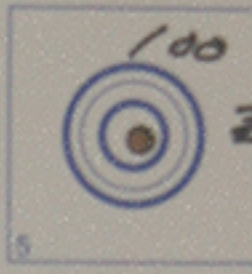

Monthly .22 Caliber Rimfire Month Long 50 Yard **Factory Class** Shooting Competition & Membership Drive.

Cost is \$10.00 per target. (The target Used for this Current Competition is "The 2021 Factory Class American Rimfire Association, Inc Blue Target"). Competitors may enter as often as they wish but only 3 times in one day. Competition goes from first day of a month to the last day of that same month.

Winner Gets 25% of the total collected pot. (if non-member) or 50% of the total collected pot. (if member) (Membership must be obtained and current at least 1 week prior to shooting of target and current through the date of scoring)

If Winning contestant is under the age of 18 at scoring, then Contestant gets 30% of the total collected pot. (if non-member) or 60% of the total collected pot. (if member) (Membership must be obtained and current at least 1 week prior to shooting of target and current through the date of scoring)

Scoring will take place on the First Tuesday of the following month between 9am and noon at the Menomonee public shooting range. We use the Official ARA Scoring System. Competitors do not need to be present at scoring to win. Winning competitor **must have ticket stub or identification matching winning target to collect.**

Supervisor must write make and model of factory class rifle on back of target & Range Official must do a visual verification that target is placed at 50 yards, and Collect target when finished on same day and Same Range Official must sign off on front of target as such. There is NO time limit.

Contestant can only take a total of 3 shots at the 3 (Sighter) Targets that are above Main Target field. (Sighter) or (Scoring) targets above main field are not part of scoring.

Contestant can only fire a total of 25 shots in main target field. If more than 25 shots are placed within the main target field then numbered targets going in reverse order from 25 to 1 are not counted per every shot fired over 25. Scoring goes in order from 1 to 25. 1 shot per numbered target field. If more than 1 shot is within numbered target field then only the lowest score in that numbered field will be accepted. Contestant will then fire 5 single shots at 5 tie breaking targets found at bottom of target to be used only in the case of a tie. 1 shot per tie breaking target If more than 5 shots are taken within the tie breaking target area than only the lowest 5 scores in the target area will be accepted. Scores from tie breaking targets are only used in the event of a tie and are not part of original scoring process.

In the event of a tie between winning competitors during scoring at the end of the month, judges will first use the 3 larger tie breaking targets found at the bottom of the main target field. If the 3 larger tie breaking targets again result in a tie judges will then use the 2 remaining smaller targets at the bottom to break the tie. Shots outside bold outer line on smaller targets will be counted as a zero score for that target.

Target must be purchased and shot on same day and only at Menomonee public shooting range.

Any Factory class .22 rifle chambered for 22 short, long or long rifle ammunition may be used.

Any type of sights are allowed.

All ammunition must be factory ammunition.

Prone, Kneeling, Sitting, Standing or at Bench with or without front and or rear rest accepted.

The winning competitor must wait to play again for 1 month or move target 25 yards farther away.

Your target purchase is acknowledgment that you the competitor agree to all rules for this competition.

One-Piece rests are strictly prohibited. The front and rear rest may not be attached to each other in any manner. (example: Lead sled)

Both the front and rear rest may not be attached to the stock at any time. Both the front and the rear of the rifle must be free to be lifted from the rest.

Anything placed under the front rest may not be attached to or contact anything placed under the rear rest.

Two-Piece rests are allowed.

Bipods are allowed. A bipod has two touch points on the bench top. If a bipod is attached, it must be used as a bipod and not attached to or placed into any other fixture.

No rest or bipod may be affixed to the bench top in an immovable manner.

No adding weight to stock or bipod, adding attachments to the barrel such as a tuner, or adding attachments to the stock such as a plate to the forearm. THIS RULE **ONLY** APPLYS TO THE FACTORY CLASS.

FACTORY CLASS MAY **NOT** HAVE ANY attachments to the barrel such as a tuner or muzzle break. A thread protector may be attached solely for the purpose of protecting the threads and must be flush with the end of the barrel. A rifle that comes from the factory with a muzzle brake must have the muzzle brake removed. **THIS RULE DOES NOT APPLY FOR THE UNLIMITED CLASS COMPETITION.**

Contestant may use a spotting scope during competition.

CONTESTANT MAY NOT GO DOWN RANGE AFTER STARTING TO SHOOT AT TARGET AND CAN ONLY GO DOWN RANGE TO RETREVE TARGET WHEN COMPLETED AND MUST TURN IN COMPLETED TARGET TO RANGE OFFICIAL AS SOON AS IT HAS BEEN RETREVED.

ANY ALTERING OF TARGET DISQUALIFYS SAID TARGET AND TARGET WILL NOT BE USED.

## What is a Factory Class Rifle?

Any rifle that is currently in production and has an MSRP under \$1,450 are automatically Approved for Factory Class.

These rifles do not need to appear on the APPROVED FACTORY RIFLE LIST.

But cannot appear on the EXCLUDED FACTORY RIFLE LIST.

Approved & Excluded Lists: Some rifles may be specifically included or excluded as noted on the Approved and Excluded Lists.

- Rifles NOT currently in production must appear on the Approved List to be eligible for Factory Class.
- Rifles listed on the Excluded List may NOT be used for factory class under any circumstances .

Monthly .22 Caliber Rimfire Month Long 50 Yard **Unlimited Class** Shooting Competition & Membership Drive.

Cost is \$10.00 per target. (The target Used for this Current Competition is "The 2021 Unlimited Class American Rimfire Association, Inc Blue Target"). Competitors may enter as often as they wish but only 3 times in one day. Competition goes from first day of a month to the last day of that same month.

Winner Gets 25% of the total collected pot. (if non-member) or 50% of the total collected pot. (if member) (Membership must be obtained and current at least 1 week prior to shooting of target and current through the date of scoring)

If Winning contestant is under the age of 18 at scoring, then Contestant gets 30% of the total collected pot. (if non-member) or 60% of the total collected pot. (if member) (Membership must be obtained and current at least 1 week prior to shooting of target and current through the date of scoring)

Scoring will take place on the First Tuesday of the following month between 9am and noon at the Menomonee public shooting range. We use the Official ARA Scoring System. Competitors do not need to be present at scoring to win. Winning competitor **must have ticket stub or identification matching winning target to collect.**

Range Official must do a visual verification that target is placed at 50 yards, and Collect target when finished on same day and Same Range Official must sign off on front of target as such. No time limit.

Contestant can only take a total of 3 shots at the 3 (Sighter) Targets that are above Main Target field. (Sighter) or (Scoring) targets above main field are not part of scoring.

Contestant can only fire a total of 25 shots in main target field. If more than 25 shots are placed within the main target field then numbered targets going in reverse order from 25 to 1 are not counted per every shot fired over 25. Scoring goes in order from 1 to 25. 1 shot per numbered target field. If more than 1 shot is within numbered target field then only the lowest score in that numbered field will be accepted. Contestant will then fire 10 single shots at 10 tie breaking targets found at bottom of target to be used only in the case of a tie. 1 shot per tie breaking target If more than 10 shots are taken within the tie breaking target area than only the lowest 5 scores in the target area will be accepted. Scores from tie breaking targets are only used in the event of a tie and are not part of original scoring process.

In the event of a tie between winning competitors during scoring at the end of the month, judges will use the 10 tie breaking targets found at the bottom of the main target field to break the tie.

Target must be purchased and shot on same day and only at Menomonee public shooting range.

Any .22 rifle chambered for .22 short, long or long rifle ammunition may be used. All ammunition must be factory ammunition. Any type of sights are allowed. Prone, Kneeling, Sitting, Standing or at Bench with or without front and or rear rest accepted.

The winning competitor must wait to play again for 1 month or move target 25 yards farther away.

Your target purchase is acknowledgment that you the competitor agree to all rules for this competition.
